PETER HOCKEN HIS FINAL CONTRIBUTION

A week before he died (he passed away on the 9th of June 2017) he delivered a huge contribution to charismatic renewal and ecumenism by presenting the history of the new dialogue and *reconciliation between the Roman Catholic Church and Messianic Jews* who believe in Jesus as their Messiah. As Peter told: The Messianic Jewish movement, a charismatic renewal among Jews, was born in the summer of 1967 in California. They have a golden jubilee, just like CCR. Peter his presentation was in Rome, Urbana University, 2nd of June 2017, in the program of the Golden Jubilee of Catholic Charismatic Renewal.
